Expectation: A Criminal Justice doctoral student and a full-time CJ faculty member will work closely over the summer in a mentoring relationship. Product outcome of the Research Fellowship is a refereed article co-authored or under the supervision of a full-time CJ faculty member published in an academic journal. The article must be completed by October 1, 2012 and submitted to the Assistant Dean for Graduate Studies accompanied by a letter/email from the journal, showing the article has been submitted and is under peer-review. Enrollment in summer semesters is not required to receive the fellowship. **Deadline to apply for the Research Fellowship is February 6, 2012.** Students receiving fellowships may also receive other funding by teaching one class, working 10 hours on a grant or in an institute. Per University Policy, students cannot work more than 30 hours (75%) during the summer. Students will receive \$6,000 if awarded a summer fellowship.

In addition, attach an abstract and a complete Methods section, including the Research Design. Also, attach a list of several illustrative sources in APA citation format, as APA style will be required for this project. All items submitted should be double-spaced; font Times New Roman 12; one-inch margins; no more than 5-6 pages should be attached to this form. Fellowship applications not following these guidelines will not be considered. Fellowship applications will be reviewed by the Graduate Standards and Admissions Committee and ranked on contribution and merit. Submit applications along with this cover sheet to Karen Eads by February 6, 2012.
